

Lishen Wu plays in Daniel Pearl World Music Days

Pianist Lizhen Wu will perform

Beethoven, Chopin and Liszt in an International Chamber Series concert that links Flower Mound in Texas to communities across the globe as part of the October "Daniel Pearl World Music Days." Since its founding in 2002, over 6,700 Music Days performances in 110 countries have created a chain that commemorates the life of Daniel Pearl and uses the power of music to reaffirm a commitment to tolerance and humanity.

After classical training as a violinist Daniel Pearl decided that reporting was his vocation and rose to become the Wall Street Journal's South Asia Bureau Chief based in Mumbai, India. He was kidnapped and assassinated by terrorists in Pakistan while working on a story about Al-Qaeda. The concert is sponsored by the Lewisville Lake Symphony in cooperation with the College of Music at the University of North Texas.

A donation to the Symphony is appreciated. Lizhen Wu, born in Yue Yang in China, is an Honorary Citizen of Flower Mound. He was given the recognition after an earlier International Chamber Series Concert that featured a quartet with two players from mainland China and two from Taiwan. He won the Hazimen Piano Competition while studying at the Wuhan Conservatory and was invited to the United States to perform at four universities, including the University of North Texas. He auditioned there for the Bachelor of Performing Arts degree and was accepted as a freshman performance major in the fall of 2006 on a scholarship. 
