**About World Music Days.** The day after the world learned that Wall Street Journal reporter and musician Daniel Pearl had been murdered in Pakistan, conductor George Phelivanian (Danny's neighbor and friend) decided to dedicate his concert to Danny. It was an emotional event, ending with a 15 minute ovation. After Danny's funeral, his family decided to inspire hope for a hate free world through music and words; inviting musicians worldwide to dedicate a performance on what would have been Danny's 39<sup>th</sup> birthday - October 10, 2002. Thus, the seeds were planted for Daniel Pearl Music Days- now 2 weeks of worldwide concerts using the universal language of music to unite audiences everywhere in "Harmony for Humanity."
