World Music Days is inspired by the life and work of journalist and musician Daniel Pearl, who would have been celebrating his birthday each year on October 10th. Music is a unique bridge-builder, and "Harmony for Humanity" is the theme of Daniel Pearl World Music Days. We will be a part of a global network of concerts that uses the Universal Language of Music to extinguish hatred, respect differences, and reach out in global friendship.

Daniel Pearl was a newspaper reporter and a classically-trained violinist, as well as a fiddler and mandolin player, who joined musical groups wherever he traveled, working toward cross-cultural understanding with simply a pen and a fiddle, using music to make friends in many countries. In 2002, he was murdered by terrorists while investigating a story in Pakistan. His family decided to carry on Danny's work and use music to help people learn to respect each other and honor diversity.

"Harmony for Humanity, World Music Days" commemorates and carries on his mission of connecting diverse people through words and music. Every October musicians all over the world dedicate concerts to the shared vision that even though we may have different races, religions, ethnic backgrounds, or spiritual beliefs, we can all work together to achieve a better peaceful, love-filled world for everyone.

During our event we will join people around the world in a tribute to all the visionary men and women who use the power of music to lift the spirits of peoples from different backgrounds and to diminish beliefs about the perceived differences that set us apart. Through our music, we will join thousands of music lovers around the world, helping to send out the musical and heart-felt vibrations with an affirmation of the Oneness of Humankind.

Through our participation we will reaffirm our conviction that Humanity will triumph, and Harmony will prevail. We will remind others to put aside our differences, and to celebrate our similarities. Music is a unique bridge-builder, and "Harmony for Humanity" is the bridge that will cross cultural differences and bring harmony to the world.
